antibiotic (nt b t k) a chemical substance derivable from a mold or bacterium that kills microorganisms and cures infections

bibliography (b bl gr f) a list of writings with time and place of publication (such as the writings of a single author or the works referred to in preparing a document etc.)

biodegradable (b ohd gr d b l) capable of being decomposed by e.g. bacteria

biofeedback (b ohf db k) a training program in which a person is given information about physiological processes (heart rate or blood pressure) that is not normally available with the goal of gaining conscious control of them

biography (b gr f) an account of the series of events making up a person's life

biology (b l j) the science that studies living organisms

biome (b ohm) a major biotic community characterized by the dominant forms of plant life and the prevailing climate

biopsy (b ps) examination of tissues or liquids from the living body to determine the existence or cause of a disease

microbiology (m krohb l j) the branch of biology that studies microorganisms and their effects on humans

symbiosis (s mb ohs s) the relation between two different species of organisms that are interdependent; each gains benefits from the other
