**hyperbole**  $(h^{\overline{1}}p\hat{u}rb^{\overline{u}}l^{\overline{e}})$  extravagant exaggeration

hyperventilate breathe excessively hard and fast

**illicit**  $(\bar{1}1\bar{1}s\bar{u}t)$  adjective

1. contrary to accepted morality (especially sexual morality) or convention

2. contrary to or forbidden by law

**inaudible**  $(\bar{1}n\hat{0}d\vec{u}b\vec{u}l)$  *adjective* impossible to hear; imperceptible by the ear

**incorrigible**  $(\bar{1}nk\bar{o}r\bar{u}j\bar{u}b\bar{u}l)$  *adjective* impervious to correction by punishment

infamy  $(\bar{1}nf\bar{u}m\bar{e})$  noun **1.** a state of extreme dishonor **2.** evil fame or public reputation

**insipid** *adjective* lacking taste or flavor or tang
