**accumulate** (ũkyōōmyũlā̄t) Get or gather together.

**acrophobia** a morbid fear of great heights

**admittance** (ũdm̄l̄tũns)

1. the right to enter
2. the act of allowing someone to enter

**ambidextrous** (āmbũdēkstrũs) equally skillful with each hand

**ambiguous** (āmb̄l̄gyōōũs) having more than one possible meaning

**ambivalent** (āmb̄l̄vũl̄ũnt) uncertain or unable to decide about what course to follow

**amorphous** (ũmôrfũs) having no definite form or distinct shape

**amphibious** (āmf̄l̄bēũs)

1. relating to or characteristic of animals of the class Amphibia
2. operating or living on land and in water

**anesthetic** (ānũsthē̄t̄k) a drug that causes temporary loss of bodily sensations

**apathy** (āpũthē̄) an absence of emotion or enthusiasm; indifference
