incandescent (ɪnkændɛsnt) emitting light as a result of being heated

inception (ɪnsɛpʃn) an event that is a beginning; a first part or stage of subsequent events

infer (ɪnfɪr) to conclude something on the basis of evidence or reasoning

inscription (ɪnskrɪpʃn)

1. letters inscribed (especially words engraved or carved) on something
2. a short message (as in a book or musical work or on a photograph) dedicating it to someone or something

intervene (ɪntɪvɛn) get involved, so as to alter or hinder an action, or through force or threat of force

misfire (mɪsfɪr) fail to fire or detonate

mishap (mɪʃæp) an unpredictable outcome that is unfortunate

misnomer (mɪsnɒmɪr) an incorrect or unsuitable name

misunderstand (mɪsʊndɪrstænd) interpret in the wrong way

nonsense (nɒnsɛns) having no intelligible meaning
