**obnoxious** (obnokshuhs)

1. causing disapproval or protest
2. Annoying, bothersome to an extreme extent; Irritating.

**obtrusive** (uhbtroosihv)

1. undesirably noticeable
2. sticking out; protruding

**panacea** (panuhseeuh) hypothetical remedy for all ills or diseases; once sought by the alchemists

**pandemic** (pandEHmihk) an outbreak of disease affecting many people over a wide area

**panoply** (panoplee) a complete and impressive array

**pericardial** located around the heart or relating to or affecting the pericardium

**periphery** (purihfuree) the outside boundary or surface of something

**precursor** (preekursur) an indication of the approach of something or someone

**predilection** (prEHduhLEHkshuhn) a predisposition in favor of something

**prejudice** (prEHjuhdihs) a partiality that prevents objective consideration of an issue or situation
