**proclivity** (prohkl ǐvũtē) A natural or habitual inclination or tendency,(especially of human character or behavior)

**profuse** (prũfy 00s) produced or growing in extreme abundance

**prologue** (prohl 00g) opening speech or dialogue of a play or the introduction to any literary work

**provoke** (prũvohk) annoy continually or chronically

**rejuvenate** (r ǐj 00vũn 00t) return to life; get or give new life or energy

**secede** (s ǐs 00d) withdraw from an organization or communion

**sedition** (s ǐd ǐshũn) an illegal action inciting resistance to lawful authority and tending to cause the disruption or overthrow of the government

**subconscious** (sũbk 00nshũs) Not wholly conscious; existing in the mind but not fully perceived or recognized.

**submarine** (sũbmũr 00n) a submersible warship usually armed with torpedoes

**subterranean** (sũbtũr 00n 00ũn) being or operating under the surface of the earth
