antidote (ǎnt ĩdoht) a remedy that stops or controls the effects of a poison

antifreeze (ǎnt ěfr ěz) a liquid added to the water in a cooling system to lower its freezing point

antipathy (ǎnt ĩpũth ě) A strong feeling of dislike, distaste, or opposition.

beneficent (b ěnũf ĩshũnt) doing or producing good

benefit (b ěnũf ĩt) something that aids or promotes well-being

bicycle (b ĩs ĩkũ) a wheeled vehicle that has two wheels and is moved by foot pedals

biped having two feet

centigrade (s ěntũgr ād) the thermometric scale that uses 0 degrees as the freezing point and 100 degrees as the boiling point

centiliter a metric unit of volume equal to one hundredth of a liter
