dissipate (dɪsɪpəteɪt)

1. to cause to separate and go in different directions
2. move away from each other

dissuade (dɪswədeɪd) turn away from by persuasion

edict (ɛdɪkt) a legally binding command or decision entered on the court record (as if issued by a court or judge)

eloquent (ɛlɔkwɪnt) expressing yourself readily, clearly, effectively

empathy (ɛmpəθi) understanding and entering into another's feelings

erode (ɪroʊd) become ground down or deteriorate

exclusion (ɪksklʊʒən) a deliberate act of omission

exhume (ɛkshyʊm) dig up for reburial or for medical investigation; of dead bodies

expunge (ɪkspʊŋj) remove by erasing or crossing out

extort (ɪkstɔrt) obtain by coercion or intimidation
