1.	<b>incorrigible</b>	in- , <u>not,without</u> + corrigible
2.	<b>foreboding</b>	fore- , <u>before</u> + boding
3.	<b>hyperventilate</b>	hyper- , <u>excessive</u> + ventilate
4.	<b>infamy</b>	in- , <u>not,without</u> + famy
5.	<b>inaudible</b>	in- , <u>not,without</u> + audible
6.	<b>hyperactive</b>	hyper- , <u>excessive</u> + active
7.	<b>hyperbole</b>	hyper- , <u>beyond</u> + bole
8.	<b>illicit</b>	il- , <u>not</u> + licit
9.	<b>forecast</b>	fore- , <u>before</u> + cast
10.	<b>insipid</b>	in- , <u>not,without</u> + sipid

**foreboding** (fôrbôhd īng)

1. a feeling of evil or danger to come
2. make a prediction about; tell in advance

**forecast** (fôrk āst) a prediction about how something (as the weather) will develop

**hyperactive** (h īpûr ākt īv) more active than normal

**hyperbole** (h īpûrb ũl ē) extravagant exaggeration

**hyperventilate** breathe excessively hard and fast

**illicit** (īl īs ũt) *adjective*

1. contrary to accepted morality (especially sexual morality) or convention
2. contrary to or forbidden by law

**inaudible** (īnôd ũb ũl) *adjective* impossible to hear; imperceptible by the ear

**incorrigible** (īnk ôr ũj ũb ũl) *adjective* impervious to correction by punishment

**infamy** (īnf ũm ē) *noun*

1. a state of extreme dishonor
2. evil fame or public reputation

**insipid** *adjective* lacking taste or flavor or tang
