Course Description

Math 1 is the first course of a three-year sequence of integrated math courses that incorporate the new state standards and Practice Standards in Mathematics. The purpose of Math I is to develop students' ability to think mathematically and develop their conceptual understanding of mathematics and procedural fluency in mathematics. Math I will extend the mathematics students learned in earlier grades and begin the development of concepts in Number and Quantity, Algebra, Functions, Modeling Data, Geometry, and Statistics.
