

Creative Genius Research Project and Presentation

With one or two other people in your group you will select a person who you believe was or is a creative genius. Your team will answer these basic questions about the creative genius you selected:

1. What is it that makes your individual a creative genius? What accomplishments/creations has your personality done?
2. Has their creativity helped or improved other people's lives? What impact did the creative genius's works have on culture? On the world?
3. Historical background of your individual. Is there anything unusual or unique about their lives that might help explain why they stand out as creative geniuses? If pertinent include information about their childhood, parents, siblings, home, unusual talents, personality etc.
4. Why do you believe this individual is a creative genius?

Your presentation should include multiple visuals, examples of the individual's creative genius, and be fun! The presentation should be from five to ten minutes. All members of the group should participate in the presentation.

Select a creative genius then confirm with me. You must be able to justify why your individual is a creative genius. Your creative genius may come from any background such as science, music, art, literature, film, technology, or many other creative endeavors. Once an individual is selected no other team may select the same individual.
