1. Review “Needs” discussion that we had at our October DELAC meeting. Jill is going to distribute a list of suggestions from our last meeting and groups will prioritize the top 5 items on the front page and top 3 items on the back page. Groups shared their priorities for both sides of the paper.
2. FPM Documents – Faythe distributed the DELAC interview information. There will be a prep meeting for parents only on January 30th at 6:00 pm to prepare for the FPM visit on February 4th in the afternoon. The parents are spending some time to review the questions. There may need to be childcare since it is an early out for elementary and middle school. We will need a translator for the meeting with the FPM committee. Faythe reviewed the questions with the group to prepare for the upcoming January meeting. We get Title III funds to support ELlevation program, aides for the high school support classes, training for teachers in strategies and who support EL students.



3. Dashboard preview – Mary led the group in an activity to review the District Dashboard information. She reviewed the gas tank icons and had the groups review the district data for overall, ELA, math, graduation rate, college/career, chronic absenteeism and suspension. Groups shared out things they noticed including: foster youth being in the red for 4 indicators, RFEP students outperforming English only students in ELA and math, graduation rate being one of the highest in the state and English learners being in yellow for ELA, math and college/career.
