VALERIE BACKUS: CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION (CTE)

Typical American Educational Model:

- 1. Graduate from high school
- 2. Go to college (6 out of 10 students who started [college] will not have a degree after six years)
- 3. Get a job
- 4. Pay back student loans
- 5. Figure out what job/career to get

CTE model

- 1. What are you good at and interested in? Explore (in middle school and 9th grade)
- 2. 9th grade: Learn, try, decide to continue or go another direction
- 3. Career goal "for now" using CTE (get hand on education and experience)
- 4. Career plans with options and competitive advantage (college credits, certifications, industry connections, work experience, etc.)





ON THE JOB TRAINING

Employee training at the place of work while doing the actual job, usually under a professional trainer or experienced employee.



APPRENTICESHIP

A learner/apprentice receives on the job training under an expert. Apprenticeships include additional study (classroom work and reading). Available in a wide variety of industries.



TRADE/VOCATIONAL/TECHNICAL SCHOOL

Schools that focus on skills of a specific trade (such as computer coding/networking, welding, machining, construction) using industry standard books of the trade and manuals as well as "hands on" teaching.



COMMUNITY

A "CC" offers technical and general education courses for two years beyond high school for a degree or certificate. Option to transfer to a four-year college.



GAP YEAR

A break between secondary school and higher education.



SERVICE CORPS

Free residential educational and job training through organizations that service communities through fulfilling a shared purpose.



Examples:

Job Corps Peace Corps AmeriCorps Teach for America (formerly Teacher Corps)



Joining any of the 5 military branches allows students to serve their country and receive educational training for nearly all careers. The military provides education as well as world-wide travel opportunities.



COLLEGE

Schooling that offers students a 4-year degree in a specific area (for example a Teacher's College).



UNIVERSITY

An institution that houses several colleges on its campus or under its influence. For example, a university may have a college of education, a college of business, and a medical college under its "university" umbrella.






