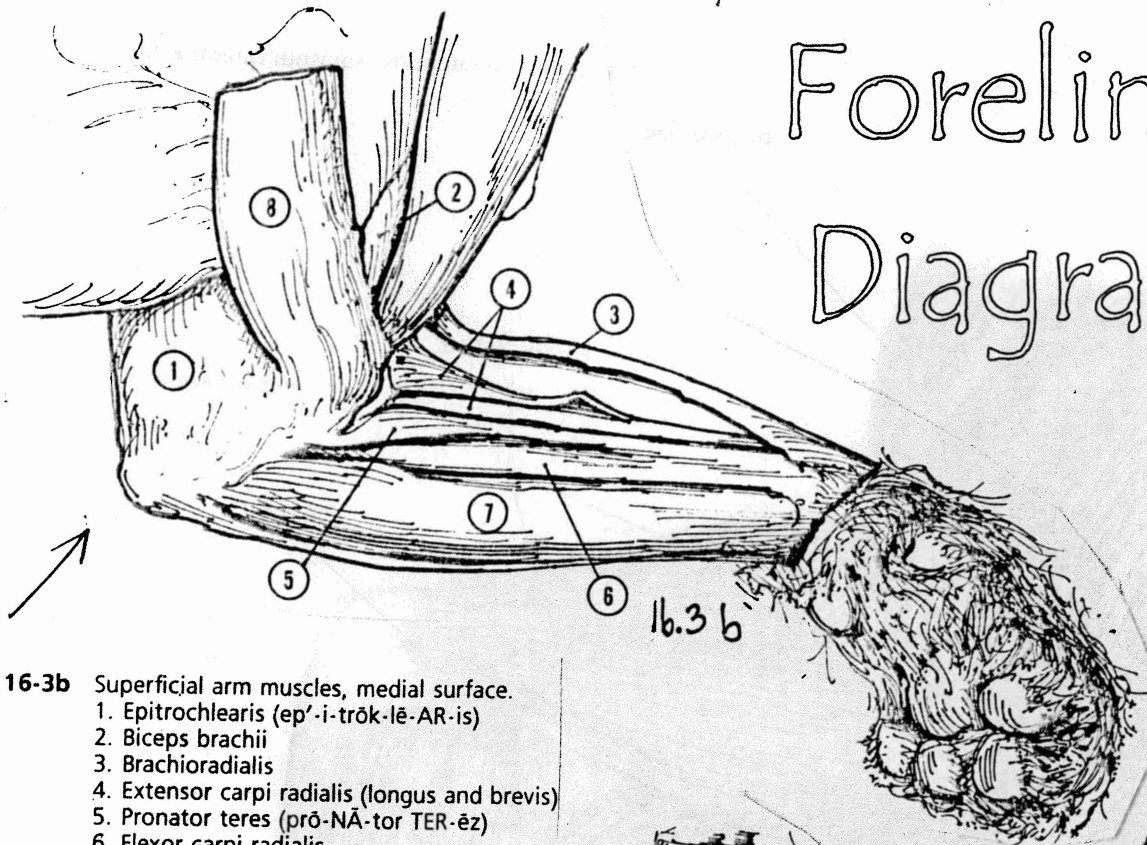


Figure 16-3b Superficial arm muscles, medial surface.

8. Pectoantebrachialis

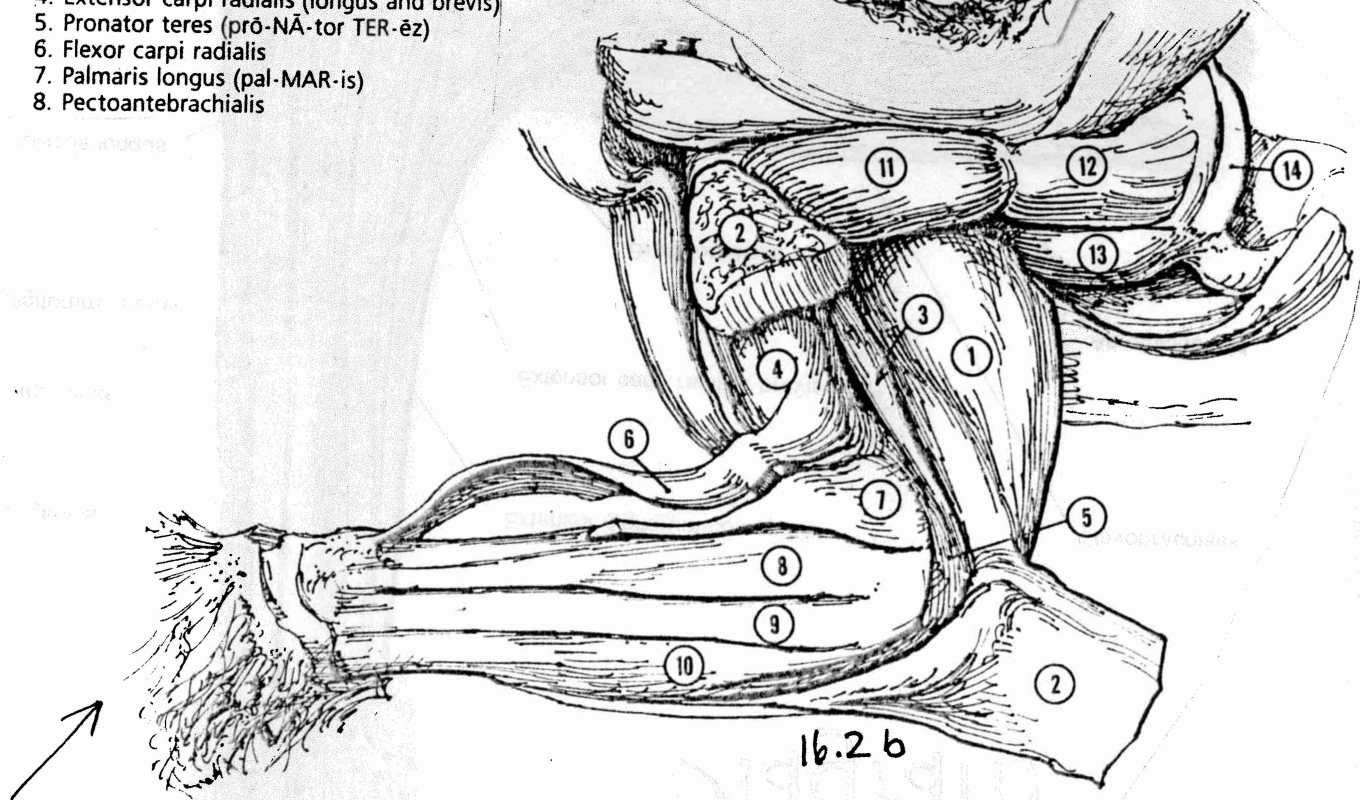
