The Stamp Act

- In 1765, The Stamp Act was passed by the British Parliament. The Stamp Act was a tax to pay for the French and Indian war.

People were taxed for papers, documents, licenses, newspapers, etc.



The Boston Massacre

The Boston Tea Party



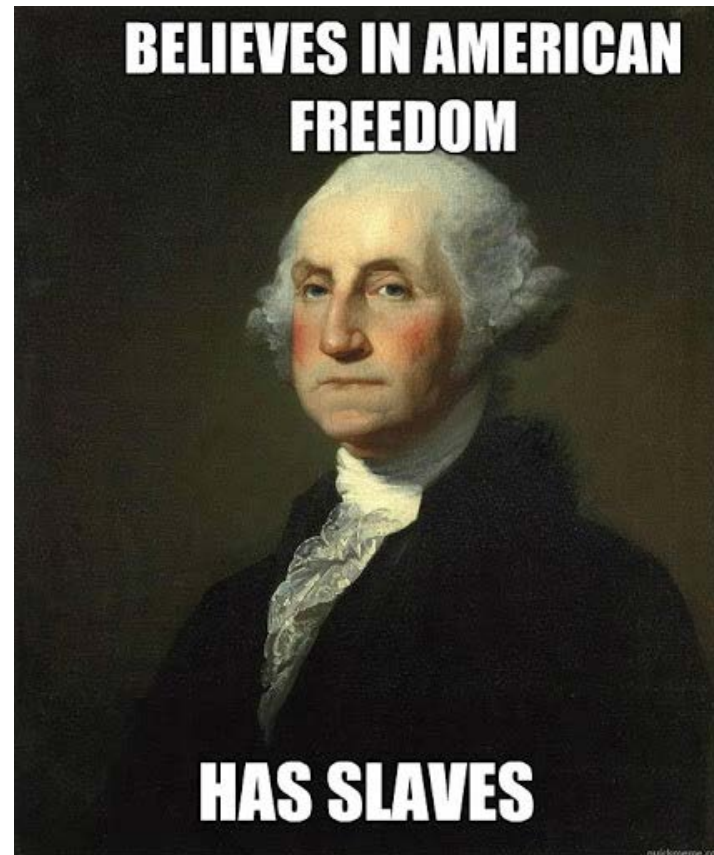

On April 19, 1775 the British left from Boston to capture Samuel Adams and John Hancock in Lexington and to destroy the weapons and ammunition that the Americans stored in Concord.
