Attendance:

In order to avoid this, please only submit work to Canvas and Turnitin.com as instructed for each assignment.

Late Work:

If a student misses a deadline for an assignment, they will have an opportunity to complete it within the current 6-week grading period. Canvas has time stamped deadlines that will state the assignment is late. Any point deduction is at teacher discretion and based on quality of submission. If an assignment is late that is turned in on Turnitin.com, the student will need to contact the teacher, so the assignment may be unlocked.
