Because this is a skills class, there will be no homework assigned by me. The grade for this course is solely based on classroom participation, attendance, and punctuality.

Grading breakdown:

3 points per day (entered weekly on AERIES/ABI) are awarded for:

- 1 point for being here on time
- 1 point for working on task for the whole period
- 1 point for agenda/backpack/binder in order
- An excused absence will receive credit for the day

If your child has no missing assignments in core classes, they will be working on the following:

- Reviewing math concepts
- Re-reading of current lessons in core classes
- Studying for upcoming assessments
- Focused note taking
- Upcoming projects/reports
- Organization of binder/backpack
