#### • **ANSWERS**

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- CL: C> Cylinder-like shape (glass, cup, bottle, large candle, etc.)
- CL: CC> Large cylinder-like shape: lamppost, coffee can, flower pot, plate, UFO, bucket, trash can, drum, etc.
- CL: F small round flat disk-like shape: coin, button, etc.
- CL: LL round flat disk-like shape: a saucer, clock face, circular picture, large platter, place mat or frame
- CL:C \* (CARRY-TO)a book, a flat box, box of candy, stack of paper etc.
- CL: O\* thin flat objects sheet of paper, magazine, etc.
- CL: 5 (double dots over the '5' means claw shaped): small round objects like baseball, an apple, orange, etc.
- CL: S handle –like objects with handles like broom, pitcher, mug, etc.
