


Embedding Your Twitter Feed Tutorial

Step One: Select “Resources” from the sidebar of your Twitter page



Step Two: Select “Widgets” from the Twitter Resources page



Step Three: Select “Widgets for My Website” from the Twitter Widget page


Step Seven: Copy the code so that you can paste it into your Schoolwires editor
