Distance Learning Grading Procedures

According to the district letter on distance learning grading procedures that you received, all work assigned prior to and due by March 13, 2020 can be graded as it was at the time it was assigned. If your child has work to make up (missed homework, missed review sheet, missed class assignment), please contact me so we can decide on the make-up time and assignment that can be graded and inputted into Aeries as a grade prior to or by April 17.

The Distance Learning starting on Monday April 6, 2020 is designed to ensure students can continue learning math content knowledge and skills until the end of the semester. Students should be learning as much as they can in order to prepare for the math class they plan to take next year. To encourage continued learning, the Murrieta Mesa High School Math Department has developed a way to improve grades during the distance learning from April 6th until the end of the semester. It is expected that students are following the usual classroom standards for completed work when submitting assignments.

The amount a student participates will determine the increase in their grades, as follows:

Distance Learning Completion Rate	Grade Bump
0-50% Completion Rate	0%
51-60% Completion Rate	5.1-6.0%
61-70% Completion Rate	6.1-7.0%
71-80% Completion Rate	7.1-8.0%
81-90% Completion Rate	8.1-9.0%
91-100% Completion Rate	9.1-10.0%

*As an example: if current grade is an 80.8% and student earns **credit** for 93% of the assigned distance learning work, then they receive 9.3 percentage points so the final semester grade would be 90.1%

*If your current grade is an F, it is possible to raise your grade to a D-. Please communicate with me for more information.

* All grade bumps will be added at the end of the semester based on percent in Distance Learning Category in Aeries gradebook.

***Progress report grades will be submitted on April 17. This grade will reflect all work completed prior to us leaving school on March 13. Any missing assignments in Aeries prior to March 13 must be turned in by April 16th, to be included in the progress report grade.

As we progress through the remainder of the school year, it is important that students continue to do all assignments. These assignments will help prepare students for their next math class.
