What is Resiliency?

Resilience is the ability to bounce back after challenges and tough times.

Resilient children can recover from setbacks and get back to living life.


Resilience develops when children experience challenges and learn to deal with them positively.

Think about these tips for being resilient in school:

- ✓ Allow them to learn from their mistakes
- ✓ Allow them to try to solve their problems before jumping in to save them
- ✓ Allow them to get and keep themselves organized
- ✓ Continue to encourage and support them
- ✓ When they are experiencing challenges, ask them, "Do you need me to get involved, do you want advice, or would you just like me to listen?"
- ✓ After making a choice, ask them, "If you had to do it again, would you make the same choice or a different one"?

I say, "I want to help you, but I want you to help yourself first"

- ✓ Leave GUM at home!!



Remediation Steps


Reset: Student Stops Unwanted Behavior & Self Starts Again

Redirect: Teacher Stops Unwanted Behavior & Advises to Start Again

Restorative Justice: Student Shares What Happened & Takes Responsibility for their Actions & Makes Amends

Restorative Circle: Class Addresses Situation & Offers Solutions

Restorative Conference: Teacher & Student's Family Discuss Solutions

60% Assessments, Projects & Essays


40% Practice Work



Supplies

Students should have pencils, paper, & all supplies daily

Basic Supplies:

- 2 Composition books
 - **Purple for Social Studies and Green for Language Arts.
- One 3-ring binder with dividers
- 2-3 sharpened pencils, erasers, lead if they have a mechanical pencil
- Loose leaf paper
- Colored pencils, crayons, pens, highlighters or crayons
- Index cards
