Letter From Our Principal

Dear Parents and Students,

Recently, Riverside County announced it has moved to the red tier of the State of California - County COVID-19 Monitoring System. The red tier permits schools to re-open and bring students back on campus for limited instruction, as long as Riverside County remains in the red tier for a minimum of fourteen days. Our district will continue to work collaboratively with our employee associations towards a phased re-opening plan with a priority on returning students to school safely and smoothly. Moving towards traditional schooling is a gradual process as we follow the county guidelines and move forward in the County COVID-19 Monitoring System, as we edge towards the orange and yellow tiers.

Please visit our district website: www.murrieta.k12.ca.us to connect to the virtual meeting at 5 p.m. on Thursday, October 8, 2020. This presentation will include noted modifications made to the school environment, health and safety expectations and projected timelines for welcoming our students back to campus. We have moved into our second six-week grading period.

During these difficult times, we are seeing that across our district there has been a drop in student grades. We are working diligently behind the scenes to develop support systems, to make calls and make home visits. We are seeing clearly many of the challenges that our students and families are facing. We strongly encourage students to participate in office hours from 1:15 to 2:30 Tuesday through Friday. This month our school district is unveiling a new program called Paper in which all students can receive live 24/7 tutoring. This will be an opportunity for them to chat with a tutor to receive additional academic support.

The library remains open Mondays and Thursdays for student textbook and device checkout from 7:30 to 2:30. We held a virtual rally in September and a virtual Back to School Night. Our video production class is posting the Nighthawk News twice each week. Several of our athletic teams have begun conditioning after school. We look forward to some of our other programs to be granted this opportunity soon to help engage our students.

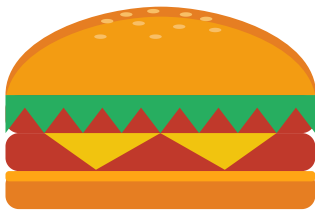
