Letter From Our Principal

Dear Parents and Students,

Our first month of the 20-21 school year was indeed revolutionary one. The first month was filled with many challenges, growing pains and successes. Our teachers spent a great deal of time developing the skills to work with our new learning management system, Canvas, and setting up virtual classrooms in Teams and Zoom. Many have added new terms to our vocabulary and a clear understanding of synchronous (face to face) teaching and asynchronous (recorded) teaching.

Be sure and take advantage of “Office Hours” each and every day to connect with teachers for extra help. Also check grades in Aeries regularly. Our six week grading period ends on September 18th. We are continuing to support our school community by being available twice a week for textbook and device needs. Currently more than 25% of our students have checked out devices.

We are taking on the challenge of trying to keep our students connected through creative distance measures. This last month we held a virtual talent show with twelve talented students performing from home. We have worked to develop a strong social media presence to meet our students where they are. Our ASB is sending acknowledgement for all of our students with birthdays. They are working to begin our random acts of kindness to students at home. Our theater program is working to present virtual plays. September 14th we will have a virtual Back to School Night. Our video production class is posting the Nighthawk news.

I am grateful to have the opportunity to work with a community that is partnering to provide the best educational experiences for our students. We are looking forward to a great year at MVHS!

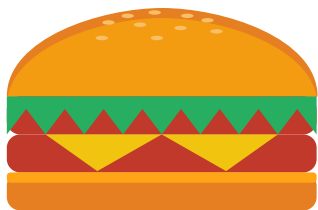

Helpful Checklist for Tech Issues

Page 2

Office 365

- ☐ Check that you can get into Office 365 with your 9 digit student ID email first – nothing else will work unless you can do this step. Go to the MVHS website and select Office 365.
- ☐ If you are a returning student (or from Thompson/Shivela), it's the same user name and password from last year. If you are a brand new student to the District, use the password provided or Mvusdmmd! (mm = your birth month and dd = your birthdate. Don't forget the !)
- ☐ If you cannot get into Office 365, please contact kgaines@murrieta.k12.ca.us for a password reset.
- ☐ If you are a new student trying on a borrowed Chromebook from school for the very first time, STOP. You must complete this step first on a different device – phone, another computer, iPad, Mac, etc

Canvas

- ☐ **Log into your Office 365 first.**
- ☐ Once you are logged into Office 365, click on the link for Canvas.
- ☐ Do NOT try to create a Canvas account or log in using another email address. It will not work.
- ☐ Courses are listed to the left – click on the Course you are looking for. If you are missing a course, please wait 24 hours if you have had a schedule change – if not, contact your counselor.
- ☐ If you need to connect with your teacher, use the Inbox, also listed on the left.
- ☐ Pair code instructions (for parents to link with their students) are available on our website.

Aeries

- ☐ **If you are a brand new student, you must set up your Aeries account.** (See Instructions on the back)
- ☐ If you already have an Aeries account use the Forgot Password feature and follow the prompts.
- ☐ Email code is NOT the same as verification code. Email code will come up automatically when you click on the email from Aeries.
- ☐ If you need a verification code, please contact (A-K) Mrs. Velasquez, (L-Z) Mrs. Young or Mrs. Gaines.

Zoom/Teams

- ☐ Find your links to Zoom/Teams on the individual teacher Canvas pages.
- ☐ If you cannot access Zoom/Teams, please contact your teacher directly via email/Inbox to let them know. Each teacher sets up their own Zoom/Teams meetings, so we cannot help you access those.

Borrowed Devices/Chromebooks

- ☐ If you have borrowed a device from MVHS, the very first time you use it, you MUST be on District wifi. It will not work without following this step.
- ☐ Please come to the campus parking lot any time, and connect via the wifi.
- ☐ If you are asked for a password, user name is mvusd, password is mvusdmvusd.

NEW Student Account Instructions

Office 365 Account (do this step first – the other steps will not work until you complete this step):

- Go to Office 365, log-in
- User name is your 9 digit student ID number
- Default password is Mvusdmmd! (new students ONLY - returning students, use your regular password) (mm is your birth month, dd is your birthdate. If your birthday is March 4th, your password would be Mvusd0304! Be sure the M is capitalized and you include the !)
- Once you have logged in, go to Outlook. This is your email account. Your email address is 9 digit student ID@mvusd.org

Canvas

- The link for Canvas is on the front page of our website
- Log in using your Office 365 account first, then click on Canvas
- Once you have logged in, your classes should be listed on the left under Courses.
- If you have had a schedule change, please allow 24 hours for your new classes to appear.

Aeries

- <https://aeriesnet.murrieta.k12.ca.us/parent/LoginParent.aspx?page=Default.aspx>
- Select Create New Account, select Student (not Parent)
- Follow the prompts. You can only use your 9 digit student ID email account – it will not work with Gmail, Yahoo, Hotmail, etc.
- Check your email account for an email from Aeries – click on that email to confirm your email address, it will take you back into Aeries.
- Finish following the prompts. At the end, it will ask you for your primary contact number, which is the number that you chose when setting up your Aeries account, and a verification code. Please contact Mrs. Velasquez (A-K), Mrs. Young (L-Z) or Mrs. Gaines for your verification code.

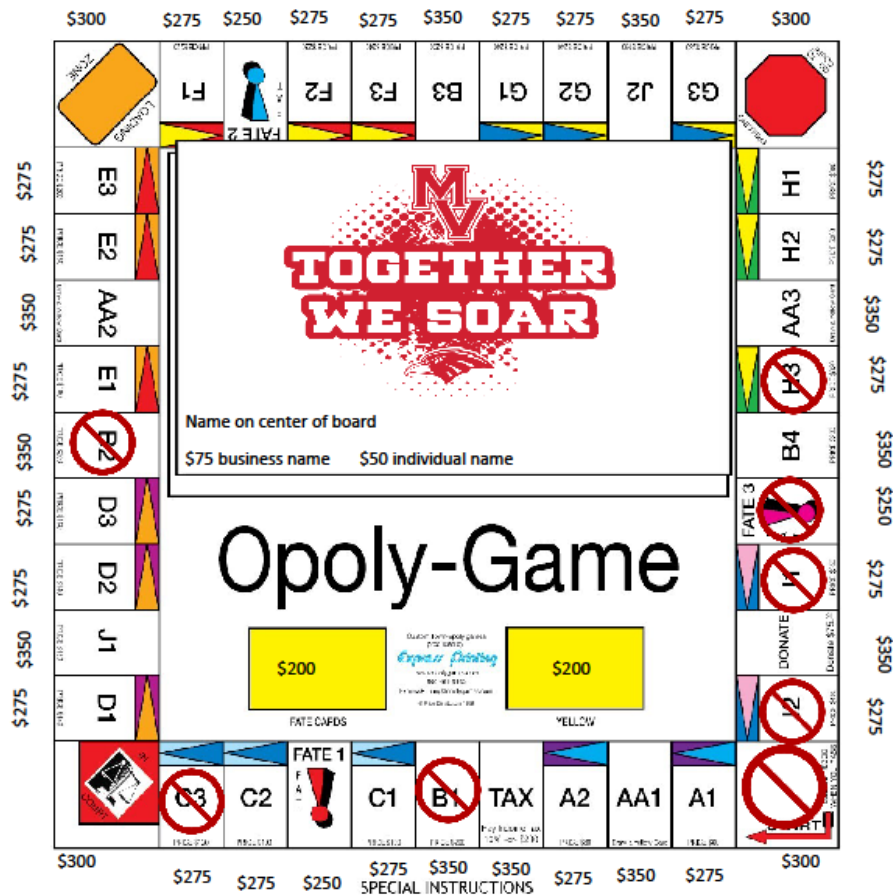

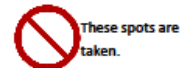
