**This week Wonders focuses on long i spelled i_e.

** This is the last week of our math curriculum. (We will then be reviewing kindergarten standards from throughout the year.) It focuses on classifying and sorting as well as graphing. These skills seem easy, but please go over them with your kiddo. The videos and interactive games are great for each day! The vocabulary is new to them and it is good to know they have the skill mastered. The packet is longer this week so if you might want to look it over before you print to see if you can do some activities without the paper. Ask your kiddo to find a way of their own to sort - this if often tricky! Flipgrid them sorting something! Tell us how many objects are in each category and which group has the greatest/least amount.

<u>Monday:</u>

- Read a book to me on <u>Raz-Kids</u>. Once you click on the book, click the microphone on the top then the red dot to record. It will send me your recording!!
- <u>iRead</u> or <u>iReady</u> for 15 minutes
- <u>Wonders</u>: Weekly opener video, have the program read literature big book <u>Hen Hears Gossip</u>, and Week 2 Vocabulary
- Reading: One page from the reading packet that corresponds to your level
- Writing: Today is May 4th May the 4th Be With You. Are you a Star Wars Fan? Write two sentences about these characters.
- Sight word page and practice Rainbow Words
- <u>Math</u>: 12.1 Math on the Spot Video then choose a group of items that are the same (fruit loops, jelly beans, Legos, blocks, buttons, beads, pom poms, Shopkins) and sort by color on the mat attached. Once the items have been sorted, count how many there are of each item and write the number underneath. Then compare the numbers and determine which group has the greatest/least number AND/OR work from math journal/corresponding leveled packet
- Log into <u>Scholastic Let's Find Out</u> and explore <u>Taking Care of Baby</u>

- <u>Math</u>: 12.2 Math on the Spot then sort by shape worksheet (attached) *Challenge: look through a magazine and cut out objects then sort by shape of object. Count and compare number of objects in each category AND/OR work from math journal/corresponding leveled packet
- Learn this song to be able to sing on Sunday! <u>Happy Mother's Day!</u>
- Movement: <u>Go Noodle- Frozen 2</u>

<u>Wednesday:</u>

• Read a book to me on <u>Raz-Kids</u>. Make sure you hit record!

- Watch on Flip Grid or Listen to and then email me your vote on which is your favorite!
- <u>iRead</u> or <u>iReady</u> for 15 minutes
- <u>Wonders</u>: Student read <u>We Can Play</u> and Phonics: Long i: i_e
- One page from the reading packet that corresponds to your level
- Writing: Finish the sentence to tell why your mom is special. Then write one more to tell your favorite thing about your mom.
- Sight word page and practice Rainbow Words
- <u>Math</u>: 12.3 Math on the Spot then sort stickers by size worksheet (use alternative manipulative if stickers not available) (attached). So far we have learned 3 ways to sort, but did you know there are many more ways to sort? Let's find a way that different objects are the same. Activities: sort and classify animals worksheet (attached), classify and sort worksheet (attached), help your mom for Mother's Day! Can you help unload the dishwasher and sort the silverware, or help sort the clothes in the laundry? Guess my sort! Sort a group of objects and have your family guess how they are sorted. Ex. Toys by color, dolls by hair color, shoes by type, animals by where they live (land/sea) AND/OR work from math journal/corresponding leveled packet
- Movement: Get Movin' Scavenger Hunt! (Attached as a PDF) Take a picture of the PDF on your phone to save paper. Upload a Flipgrid while you are on your hunt!
