This chapter is 3-dimensional geometry. We are learning the following shapes: cube, rectangular prism, cone, cylinder, and sphere. Many of the lessons ask you to use one (in the classroom we have foam blocks). At home you can find objects that are that shape. For a cylinder, use a can. For a rectangular prism, use a box. For a sphere, use a ball, etc.

I am only assigning 2 lessons this week and the mid chap checkpoint, so if you are all caught up, Friday you can do iReady Math. Or, get started on next week by doing the chapter review. We will take the chapter 11 test next week. 😊
