TK and Kindergarten Enrollment Requirements



Pre School Parents:

All Preschool students going to TK or Kindergarten, need to have their last set of shots in order to have complete immunization in compliance to state requirement prior to starting TK or Kindergarten.

Preschool students going to TK - along with complete immunization, need a Dental Exam Report Form completed by a dentist or a signed Dental Waiver prior to starting TK.

Preschool students going to Kinder - along with complete immunization, need either a Physical Exam Report Form completed by a doctor <u>and</u> Dental Exam Report Form completed by a dentist *or* a signed Physical Waiver <u>and</u> signed Dental Waiver prior to starting Kinder.

For TK Parents:

All TK students going to Kindergarten - along with complete immunization, need either a Physical Exam Report Form completed by a doctor <u>and</u> Dental Exam Report Form completed by a dentist (if not on file yet) *or* a signed Physical Waiver <u>and</u> signed Dental Waiver (if not on file yet) prior to starting Kinder.

If a Physical Exam Report Form completed by a doctor *or* a signed Physical Waiver was turned in upon TK enrollment, an updated one is needed prior to starting Kinder since "physical exam may be done up to a maximum of six months prior to entry into Kinder".

Forms/Waivers are available on our website under Kindergarten Registration or in the office.

If you have received a notice from the health office regarding needed immunization, it is important to complete them and bring the proof of shot to the health office in August or before, to get your teacher assignment

Procedure For Teacher Assignment Notification for the 2019-2020 School Year

Teacher assignment notification for the 2019-2020 school year for all students in grades Transitional Kindergarten thru 5th grade will take place August 6th during the hours of 12:00pm to 3:30pm and 5:00pm to 7:00pm in the MPR.

Please visit our school website at murrieta.k12.ca.us/buchanan after July 22, 2019 to complete the parent portal data confirmation. An automated phone call will also be sent out to remind you to complete the data confirmation, so make sure the office has your current phone number and email address on file. All data must be updated and a current *utility bill in the parents name dated June or July presented* to receive your child's teacher assignment. During the August 6th teacher assignment pick up, we will verify residency and that all sections of the parent portal data confirmation is complete. Once we verify everything has been completed, you will receive your child's teacher assignment for the 2019-2020 school year.

Parents are highly encouraged to complete the above information prior to August 6^{th.} Waiting until the last moment will result in long lines and possibly delay your student starting school on August 14th. We also highly encourage those of you with new students to Buchanan Elementary to enroll your child beginning Monday, July 29, 2019 thru Friday, August 9, 2019 when our office reopens from the summer break.

Drop-off is 8:00-8:25am for grades 1-5. Morning TK/K begins promptly at 8:20 am, Afternoon TK/K begins promptly at 11:00am.

Each morning when the 8:25am TARDY BELL rings, staff members will be at each entry gate to give out tardy slips and teachers will send any student not in class or on their line to the office for a tardy slip.

Pick-up is 2:35 pm for grades 1-3. Grades 4-5 is 2:40 pm. Afternoon K is 2:35 pm. **No staff** is available to watch students **before** 8:00am and **after** 3:00pm.

Students need to be picked up by 3:00pm. If you need supervision after 3pm, child care is available on campus for a fee. Please call our Family Services at 951-304-1623 for more information if you are interested in before or after school child care.

Murrieta Valley Unified School District 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR REGISTRATION TIMELINE

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- November 5 School Sites Accept <u>NEW</u> Intra-District Trans requests.
 *Intra-District = A transfer between schools in the MVUSD
- January 7 District accepts <u>New</u> and <u>Renewal</u> Inter-District Transfers
- February 4 Online Pre-enrollment begins for all students new to the Murrieta Valley Unified School District, including Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten students.
- February 12 Final day of Open Enrollment for New or Renewal of <u>Inter</u>-District transfer requests.
- February 12 Final day to submit (NEW) INTRADISTRICT transfer requests at the School Site.
- March 4 Onsite enrollment appointments begin for Transitional Kindergarten, Kindergarten and New enrollees. Please contact the school site to make an appointment to complete registration and turn in documents *such as*, birth certificate/verification of age, immunization records, verification of residency and more depending on the grade level of your student.
- June 10 Open Enrollment <u>INTRA</u>-district and <u>INTER</u>-district Transfer notifications to parents will be sent no later than this date.

*All other transfers that are turned in after 2/13/19 will be considered case by case

NOTE: Intra Transfer Requests between schools within the Murrieta Valley School District are processed at the school site. Please submit the request at the school site that you are requesting.

Please check the district website for Enrollment/Registration Information.
