BULLY PREVENTION

How to Identify Bullying

- **On Purpose**- Intended to cause emotional or physical harm
- **Repeated**- More than just a bad day and a bad decision, bullying is something that happens over and over
- **Unfair**- Involving a perceived or real imbalance of power
- **One Sided**- The bully is the only one using harmful behaviors, the other does nothing in return
