Graduation Information

Tickets: ALL tickets will be handed out directly following rehearsal on June 1st. Each student will receive **FIVE TICKETS** PLUS ONE for completing the FAFSA. Additional tickets can be purchased for \$10.00 from the MMHS bookkeeper on a first come, first serve basis until seats are sold out. Each graduate can buy up to 10 extra tickets. There will be limited tickets available to watch the Livestream of graduation in our theater.. **All tickets sell out quickly, please plan ahead.**

There will be **Press Box seating available in the stadium. These seats are available through an online silent auction. Contact Mrs. Vollmar or Mrs. Ruhmke in the Ram Shack for more information. All proceeds go to the Murrieta Mesa Scholarship Fund.

Attire: Students need to dress appropriately beneath their graduation gown. Shoes must be wedges or flats; spiked heels will not be allowed. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** The graduation gown/mortar board may not be altered in any way. Only Murrieta Mesa High School approved and issued cords, medals and pins may be worn with the gown. Cell phones, iPods, cameras, binoculars, drinks, flower leis, beach balls, yearbooks and purses are not permitted.

Seniors will be searched before walking onto the field and inappropriate items will be confiscated. MMHS will not be responsible for lost items.

Seating: Graduates A-L will proceed and sit on the south side of the Ram logo on the field in Ram Stadium. Graduates M-Z will proceed and sit on the north side of the Ram logo on the field in Ram Stadium. All guests in attendance will be seated on the home (east) side of Ram Stadium. There will be additional parent seating on the track.

Arrival: Students must arrive at MMHS Gym by 4:45 pm on Thursday, June 2nd. Students will NOT be permitted to bring any personal items with them such as cell phones, bags, purses, etc. ~ students are encouraged to leave their personal belongings in the car or at home. Once they are checked in, they will NOT be permitted to leave the gym. Seniors will be lined up alphabetically.

Distribution of Diplomas: Students receive their diploma cover on stage during the Commencement Ceremony. Students will receive their diploma from the staff member in their row.

*If borrowing the cap, tassel, stole or gown, students MUST return ALL items to the Jostens booth located at the North end of the field.

Senior Survey: All students must complete the online senior survey through Schoolwires. Surveys must be completed prior to senior check-out. (May 31, 2022)

Senior Check-Out: Seniors will be issued a check-out card on May 24th and May 25th, during their 5th period class.

- ➤ Bring **COMPLETED** check-out card to Mrs. Coleman as the last step in the check-out process.
- ➤ You will <u>not</u> receive commencement tickets or participate in the commencement ceremony if this card is not completed and turned in.

Senior Behavior Contract.

All seniors will turn in a signed Behavior Contract. As outlined in the Senior Behavior Contract, if seniors are suspended for any reason during second semester, they may not participate in the Commencement Ceremony. If seniors participate in any activity that involves destruction of school property (i.e., senior prank), they will not participate in the Commencement Ceremony.

Valedictorian/Salutatorian Determination:

All candidates will have their total credits equalized. All weighted courses will be counted as 5 credits per semester and be weighted on a 5-point scale. Calculation will be based on 7 semesters and the 12-week progress report of the 8th semester. All 12-week progress report corrections of the 8th semester must be made within one week from the distribution of the progress report. The calculation of GPA for Valedictorian/Salutatorian will take the number of grade points divided by the number of equalized credits.

Graduation Rehearsal: (MANDATORY)

Rehearsal will be on May 31st at 10:00 am and on June 1st at 10:00 am. Bring **WATER**, sunglasses, and sunscreen; be prepared for warm weather. All students will report to the main gym in the Impact Center for the beginning of rehearsal. Students will be seated alphabetically for the Commencement Ceremony.
