Application Process...

- **Start Application: August 1**
- **Application filing window: November 1 - 30**
- **Apply online:** <https://www.californiacolleges.edu/#/>
- **Application fee: \$70 per campus**
- **Tuition costs: approx. \$14,100 per year**
- **Other expenses: \$17,300 - \$21,300 (meals, housing and personal expenses)**
- **9 campuses**
- **Requirements are: 11 a-g courses by end of junior year with 3.0 GPA**

California State Universities

- **Filing period: October 1 – November 30**

- **Application fee: \$70 per campus**
- **Tuition costs & Campus Fees: \$6,643-\$10,071 per year**

- **Other expenses: \$16,000 - \$20,000 (meals, housing and personal expenses)**

- \$20 Application Fee to Apply to all 56 Member Institutions

- HBCUs are a source of accomplishment and great pride for the African American community as well as the entire nation. The Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, defines an HBCU as: “...any historically black college or university that was established prior to 1964, whose principal mission was, and is, the education of black Americans, and that is accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency or association determined by the Secretary [of Education] to be a reliable authority as to the quality of training offered or is, according to such an agency or association, making reasonable progress toward accreditation.” - <https://sites.ed.gov/whhbcu/one-hundred-and-five-historically-black-colleges-and-universities/>

 - 2. Mesa will electronically send your Cal Grant GPA to the CSAC
 - 3. After submitting your FAFSA or CADAA Create an Account at [WebGrants4Students](#) to check the status of your Cal Grant

Types of Cal Grants

Cal Grants

Cal Grant A

For students with a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least **3.0**, family income and assets below the state ceilings, and who demonstrate financial need

Cal Grant B

For students from disadvantaged or low income families with a GPA of at least **2.0**, family income and assets below the state ceilings, and who demonstrate financial need

Cal Grant C

For students from low income families pursuing **occupational, technical, and vocational** programs of study
