

- Tuition costs: approx. \$14,100 per year
- Other expenses: \$17,300 \$21,300 (meals, housing and personal expenses)
- 9 campuses
- Requirements are: 11 a g courses by end of junior year with 3.0 GPA

 - HBCUs are a source of accomplishment and great pride for the African American community as well as the entire nation. The Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, defines an HBCU as: "...any historically black college or university that was established prior to 1964, whose principal mission was, and is, the education of black Americans, and that is accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency or association determined by the Secretary [of Education] to be a reliable authority as to the quality of training offered or is, according to such an agency or association, making reasonable progress toward accreditation." https://sites.ed.gov/whhbcu/one-hundred-and-five-historically-black-colleges-and-universities/

Cal Grants

Cal Grant A

For students with a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least **3.0**, family income and assets below the state ceilings, and who demonstrate financial need

Cal Grant B

For students from disadvantaged or low income families with a GPA of at least **2.0**, family income and assets below the state ceilings, and who demonstrate financial need

Cal Grant C

For students from low income families pursuing **occupational**, **technical**, **and vocational** programs of study
