- CC also want FAFSA Completed





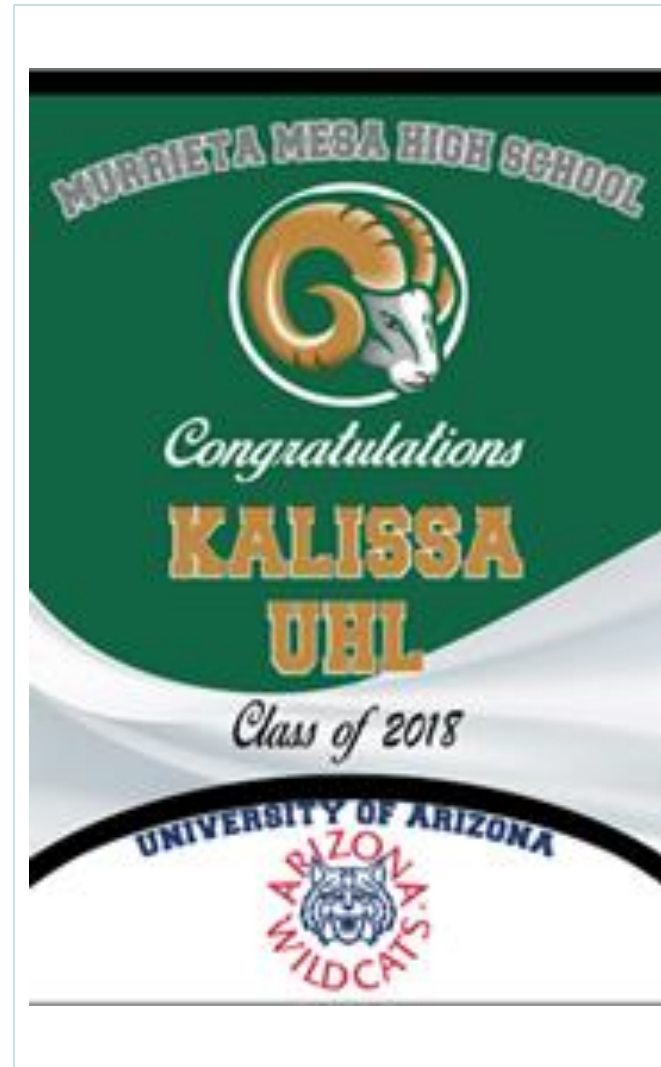
