SMART Program

We have set eight dates on the calendar for our Saturday Morning Academic Resources & Tools (SMART). This time will serve as an intervention and acceleration, based on student needs. Late Start Monday Tutoring

Why sleep in? Late start Monday mornings will now feature our instructional aides leading one hour of tutoring in our library before school begins at 8:20. National Honor Society/California Scholarship Federation student tutors will also be available during that time starting 9/9. Available to all students on a walk-in basis.

After-School Tutoring

California Scholastic Federation student tutors will be available every Wednesday for one hour after school in the library. National Honor Society student tutors will be available every Thursday for one hour after school in the library starting 9/12. Available to all students on a walk-in basis.

Office Hours

Office Hours is an intervention program which will be a 30 minute block on most Thursdays/Fridays. It is designed for the purpose of re-teaching, tutoring, study groups, make-ups, and enrichment. This is an opportunity for all of our students to receive additional help and support from their teachers during the school day.
