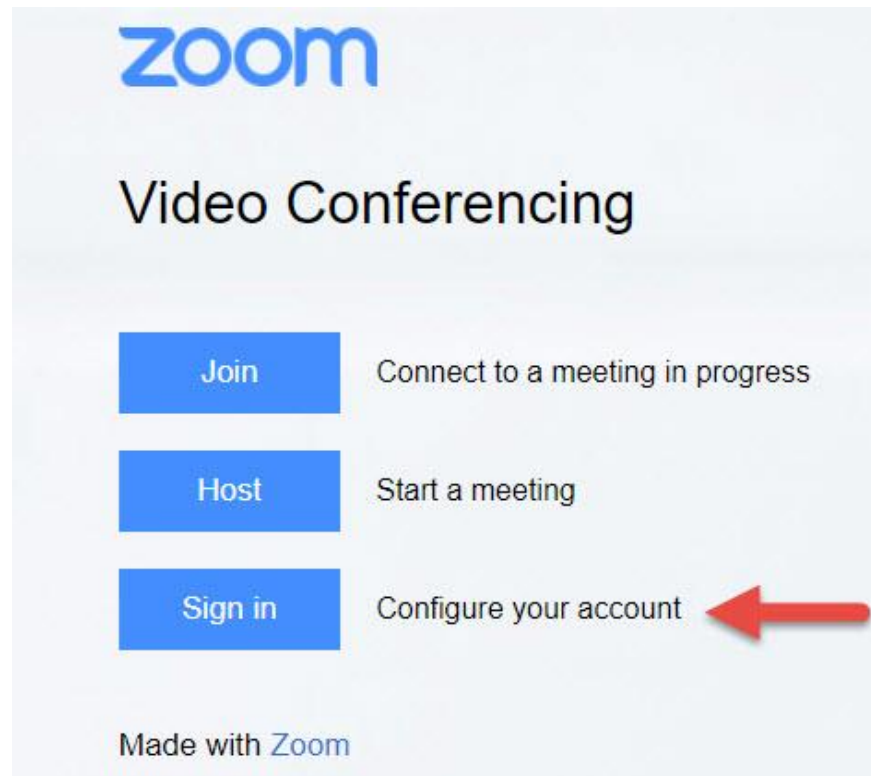
Step One


Step Two

On the Zoom Sign in page, click the blue "Sign In" button to configure your account:



Step Three

Enter your *district email address* and then click *Next*:
