


Weekly Hot Topic: RivCo advances to Red Tier (What does this mean?)


## Riverside County Advances to the State of California's Red Tier

Riverside County announced that we have progressed from the purple (widespread) to the red (substantial) pandemic spread tier. This means schools are allowed to re-open ONLY with modifications. Health & safety standards such as; pre-screening, face coverings/masks for students and staff, social distancing requirements and a minimal number of students on site are required. We continue to plan on re-opening school sites safely and smoothly in a pandemic environment. A re-opening plan will be presented to the BOE virtually on Oct.8. at 5 p.m. Re-opening teams comprised of administrators, staff members, and employee association representatives are working on two models for the BOE to consider:

#### Possible Elementary Model








Teacher assignments may change based on registration selection

### Weekly Engagement and Attendance

State of California, SB 98/AB 44 requires teachers to take daily student attendance in a virtual environment. Weekly engagement records must be signed and certified. Here are highlights from last night's BOE presentation:

- ☑ Each school site has a re-engagement team focused on connecting students.
- ✓ Preliminary data indicates district-wide attendance rate is 97.98%.
- ☑ Goal is to address barriers students have in connecting virtually and addressing those barriers holistically.
- ☑ Engagement and attendance calls to families began on 9/24.
