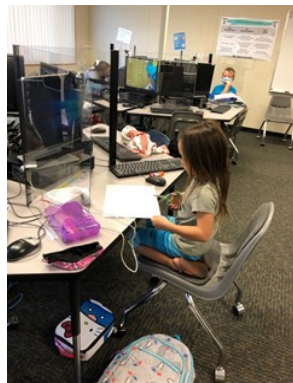




### Hot Topic of the week: Students on Campus?

## Family Services celebrates one month of successfully welcoming students on campus

As we conclude the month of September, we'd like recognize Family Services for safely and happily returning students to school sites. They have implemented a phased approach and have successfully welcomed 70% of CDC families for a total of 130 students to the SEED Childcare program. Kudos to Family Services staff, who worked collaboratively with CSEA, MEA, District Admin., State Childcare Licensing, RCOE and RivCo Public Health in ensuring a responsible return. The team's strategy was to personalize their staff and family outreach taking time to call and educate each family about health & safety measures and expectations. According to CDC Classified Employee Corynne, *"I was nervous coming back to work and being in close contact with people outside of my home. But with all the health and safety precautions, constant communication and trainings given before the reopening, my mind was put at ease.
