



Historically Black Colleges & Universities (HBCUs)

- <u>Common Black College</u>
 <u>Application (CBCA)</u>
 - \$20 Application Fee to Apply to all 56 Member Institutions



HBCUs are a source of accomplishment and great pride for the African American community as well as the entire nation. The Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, defines an HBCU as: "...any historically black college or university that was established prior to 1964, whose principal mission was, and is, the education of black Americans, and that is accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency or association determined by the Secretary [of Education] to be a reliable authority as to the quality of training offered or is, according to such an agency or association, making reasonable progress toward accreditation." - https://sites.ed.gov/whhbcu/one-hundred-and-five-historically-black-colleges-and-universities/

For students with a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least **3.0**, family income and assets below the state ceilings, and who demonstrate financial need

Cal Grant B

For students from disadvantaged or low income families with a GPA of at least **2.0**, family income and assets below the state ceilings, and who demonstrate financial need

Cal Grant C

For students from low income families pursuing occupational, technical, and vocational programs of study




