

- **Application fee: \$70 per campus**
- **Tuition costs & Campus Fees: \$6,064-\$11,955 per year**

- **Other expenses: \$18,700 - \$22,950 (meals, housing and personal expenses)**



- **Filing period: October 1 – November 30**

- **Application fee: \$80 per campus**
- **Tuition costs & Campus Fees: \$16,236 per year**

- **Other expenses: \$22,200 (meals, housing and personal expenses)**

Historically Black Colleges & Universities (HBCUs)

- Common Black College Application (CBCA)
 - \$20 Application Fee to Apply to all 56 Member Institutions



HBCUs are a source of accomplishment and great pride for the African American community as well as the entire nation. The Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, defines an HBCU as: "...any historically black college or university that was established prior to 1964, whose principal mission was, and is, the education of black Americans, and that is accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency or association determined by the Secretary [of Education] to be a reliable authority as to the quality of training offered or is, according to such an agency or association, making reasonable progress toward accreditation." - <https://sites.ed.gov/whhbcu/one-hundred-and-five-historically-black-colleges-and-universities/>

- How to Apply
 - 1. Submit [FAFSA](#) or [California Dream Act Application](#)
 - 2. Mesa will electronically send your Cal Grant GPA to the CSAC
 - 3. After submitting your FAFSA or CADAA Create an Account at [WebGrants4Students](#) to check the status of your Cal Grant

Types of Cal Grants

Cal Grants

Cal Grant A

For students with a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least **3.0**, family income and assets below the state ceilings, and who demonstrate financial need

Cal Grant B

For students from disadvantaged or low income families with a GPA of at least **2.0**, family income and assets below the state ceilings, and who demonstrate financial need

Cal Grant C

For students from low income families pursuing **occupational, technical, and vocational** programs of study




