

YEAR-ROUND SCHEDULES

The governing Board recognizes that adequate school facilities must be provided to accommodate present student enrollment as well as anticipated growth. While this may ultimately involve the construction of new facilities should be used for maximum efficiency.

The board believes that a year-round schedule is an effective way of handling the problem of over-enrollment while delivering sequential, continuous instruction which breaks up the traditional three-month summer vacation, thus reducing learning loss. The Board also believes that intersessions can provide a significant program option for either remediation or enrichment.

The Board approves the implementation of a year-round schedule at any school site.

The Superintendent or designee shall develop a year-round schedule for selected schools. The schedule shall specify the type of plan as well as the number of tracks.

It shall be the policy of the Murrieta Valley Unified School District to attempt to assign students of the same family to the same year-round education (YRE) track. It is recognized that there may be extenuating and mitigating circumstances that prohibit common placement for all family members. It shall be the policy of the district to attempt to maintain the continuity of the teacher with the class.

Federal and state holidays will be observed by all students.
