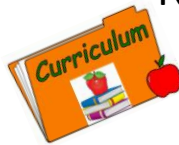

Next Curriculum Pick-up

Our next curriculum pick up will be a little different. As we get closer to the possibility of having students back on campus for in-person instruction we want to give students the opportunity to see their classroom location so each student will know where to go. On the day of your curriculum pick-up families will be allowed to walk on campus. Curriculum bags will be placed outside classrooms with student names on them. Families will be able to walk onto campus wearing masks and maintaining distance to show their child or children where classrooms are located. This will help those students returning to campus know where to go on their first day back.

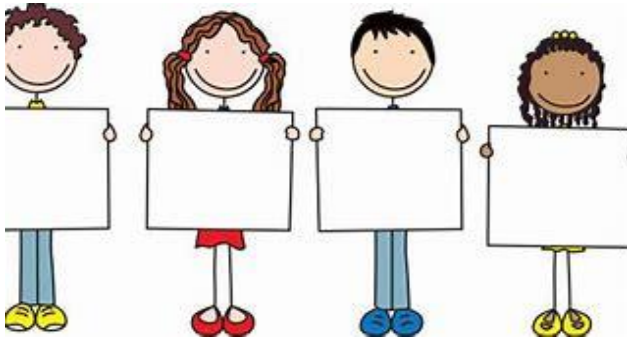
