## IReady Diagnostic Assessment

Over the next few weeks our students will start taking the English Language Arts and math IReady Diagnostic. The diagnostic is an assessment that is extremely important to obtain an accurate measurement of pre-requisite skills.

Students will be taking the diagnostic in small groups with their teacher while on Zoom or Teams. **Students are NOT to take the diagnostic on their own, and family members are not to help them so we get the most accurate data.** Students just need to do the best they can.

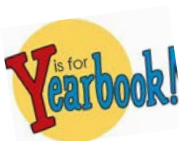
## SUPPLY PICK UP – ALL GRADES
