California law requires anyone under the age of 18 to wear a bicycle helmet when riding on the streets or sidewalks. This law pertains to anyone riding a bike, scooter, skateboard, and/or roller skates. Here are some of the basic helmet rules:

- Must fit properly.
- Must be fastened correctly.
- Must meet the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) or U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) safety standards.
