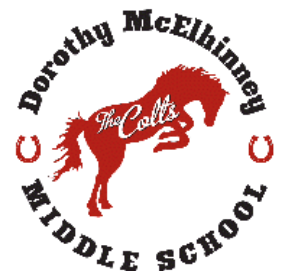

## **TK/K families:** *a special note about minimum day schedule*

The staggered dismissal may be tricky. Our best recommendation is for you to park in a designated parking spot and walk to your child's TK/K classroom for 11:40 dismissal. **Please do not park in the loop leaving your vehicle unattended.**



- *If you are waiting for a 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade sibling, **please wait in the quad** after you pick-up your TK/K child. Please avoid waiting outside your child's 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade classroom and throughout the hallways prior to the 12:00 bell.*
- *If you are NOT waiting for a 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade sibling, you may walk your child to your vehicle and then safely drive off. Please note that the loop will likely be stopped or slow moving until 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade students dismiss at 12:00, thus parking is your best option so you can leave when you're ready.*
