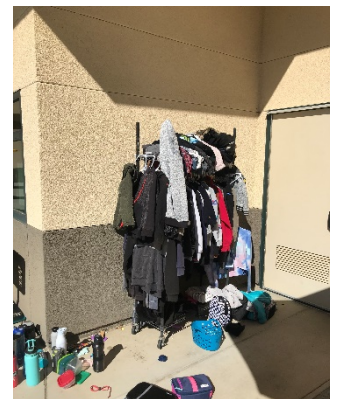
## **LJM Field of Honor**
