## **Important details about Thursday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>**

On Thursday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>, we are hosting 5<sup>th</sup> grade promotion on campus at 8:45. To help with the organization of this morning, we are changing a few things and have provided a **map on the next page** with location details. Please review this information and reach out if you have questions.

- *1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade students that want to eat breakfast on campus, will eat in the MPR.*
- *All 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will enter campus using the MPR single door entrance instead of the main vestibule. Mrs. Spoon will be there to greet you.*
- *1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will wait in the back of campus on the black top instead of in the quad before the 8:20 bell rings. We will have supervision and support to help students with this change.*

### ***Promotion***

- *Families attending promotion will line up outside of our main entrance (see map). We will have a designated area for this. Please do not sneak on campus to reserve seats or jump the line.*
- *Doors open at the main double door vestibule entrance at 7:50 for families attending promotion.*
- *Seats will be available on a first come, first served basis.*
- *Promotion begins at 8:45.*
- *Please keep in mind that it will be warm with little to no shade in the main quad. We encourage sunscreen, cold water, sunglasses, and a hat. Restrooms for visitors are in the main vestibule. Please do not use a student restroom in the main parts of the campus.*
- *Your 5<sup>th</sup> grade child will be performing and has a particular side of the outdoor stage they will be on (see map). You can possibly sit on the side of the quad, first come basis, where you can best see your child, however, please note that all students will walk center stage to receive their promotion certificate.*
- *Families may sign out their 5<sup>th</sup> grade student with their teacher after promotion. This is often a special morning for families to celebrate together off campus but be sure to properly sign out.*

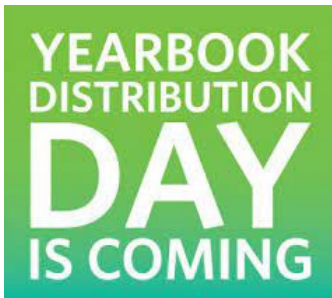
