

We are excited to kick off our Run Your Heart Out Fun Run is on September 29th. **Our goal is to raise \$50,000 for school-wide events.**

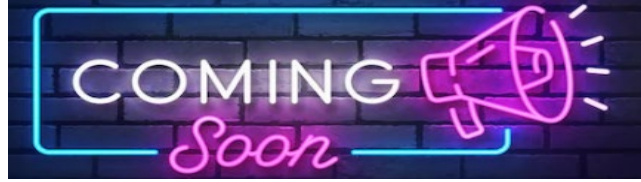
