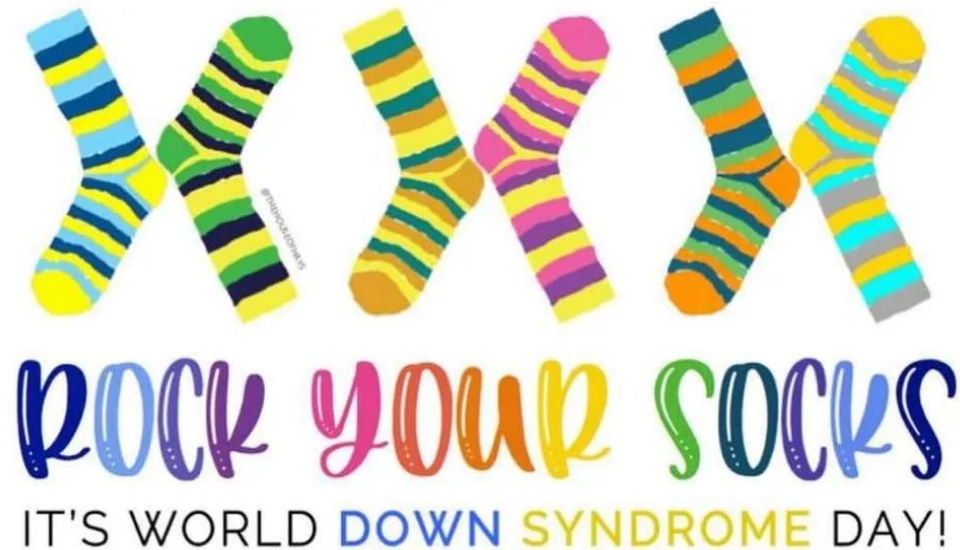
CLIMB HAS HAD 3-5 GEN ED TAS IN OUR CLASSES.

# VMHS FLASH MOB 2022

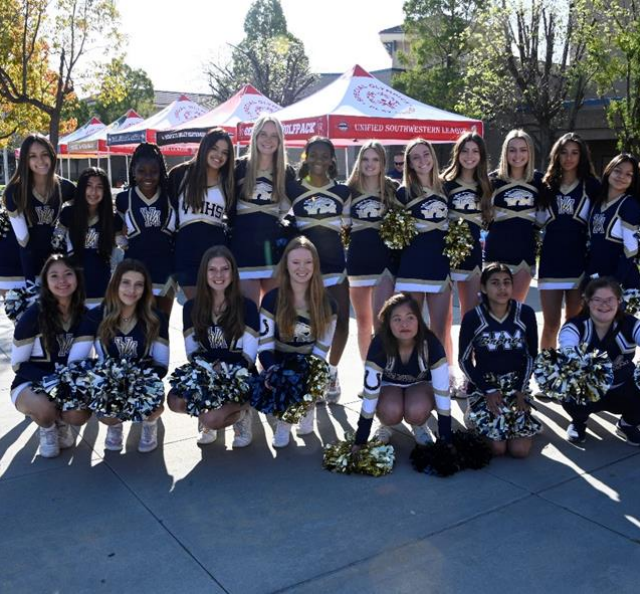
World Down Syndrome Flash Mob which all our students participated in.

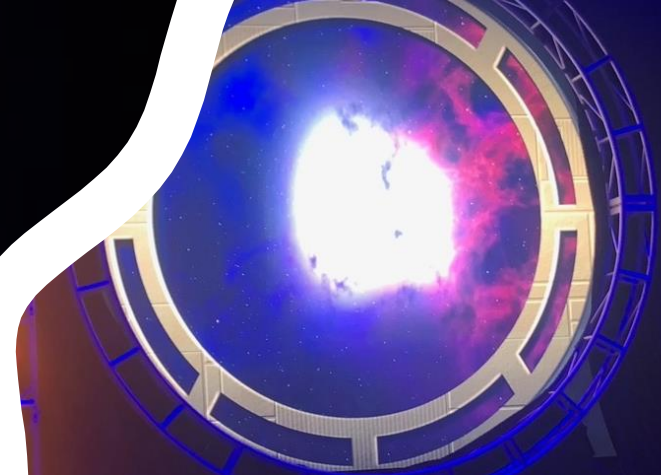
