

3rd Grade Supplies

Below is a recommended list of items your child will need for daily use. Students will be responsible for their items, which will be kept in a personal pencil box, and must be prepared at the start of each day. It helps greatly if every 3rd grader begins the new school year by contributing supplies to the classroom. I am extremely appreciative of any kind of contribution made to our classroom!

- * 2 spiral bound notebooks
- * 2 laminated 2-pocket folders
- * 1 pencil box (standard size 4x8)
- * # 2 pencils, keep 3-4 sharpened at all times in pencil box
- * pink/white eraser and pencil tops erasers
- * colored correcting pen: no blue or black ink
- * dry erase marker (no yellow) and eraser or clean sock
- * glue sticks
- * colored pencils (12-16 per box)
- * highlighter

Donated to class supply:

- * white copy paper
- * lined paper, wide ruled
- * 24 count crayons (no larger)
- * colored markers
- * page protectors
- * White glue bottles
- * Kleenex
- * Clorox wipes
- * Ziploc baggies (various sizes)
- * Band-Aids

Students may also keep the following in their pencil boxes:

- * hand held pencil sharpener must have a cover for shavings
- * scissors age appropriate for 3rd grade
