The Angel Shark is a mammal. This shark lives in many places. It lives in Northeast Atlantic: southern Norway, Sweden and Shetland Islands to Morocco and West Sahara, including the Canary Islands and the Mediterranean. The male shark can grow up to 183 centimeters long. The female shark can grow up to be 244 centimeters long. It eats small fish mollusks. When the babies are born they are called pups. There are usually 8-13 pups born in every litter and they are about 12 inches long. They are a flat bodied shark. They are not very fast swimmers but their pray are even slower. They are bottom dwellers that live in water up to 10 to 4,300 feet. They are camouflagage and they blend in with the sand and rocks. They have fins that look like wings that gave it its name Angel Shark. It is also known as the monk shark, sand devil and monkfish
