



Gorilla_s by NiCO

Mountains gorillas live in the Urunga Mountains. When male gorillas are 13 to 15 years old, their fur on their backs start turning grey, and they are called silverbacks. Gorillas eat plants. Their favorite foods are bamboo shoots, wild celery, nettles, fruit, and leaves of many kinds of trees. Silverbacks are gentle with their babies even if they look big and mean.





There are three kinds of gorillas.

- 1. Western lowland gorilla: 35,000 to 45,000 left in the wild.
- 2. Eastern lowland gorilla: 3,000 to 5,000 left in the wild.
- 3. Mountain gorilla: fewer than 400 remain.
