- Siberian tigers live in the forests of China, Siberia, and Korea.
- Big cats such as Siberian tigers have amazing hearing and seeing abilities.
- The weight of an average male is 700 lbs - 800 lbs, when a female averages around 500 lbs - 650 lbs.
- These amazing creatures grow to be about 9-12 feet long and around 3.5 feet from the ground.

- Siberian tigers have very strong jaws and hard padded paws.
- Siberian tigers eat deer and wild boar.
- During the winter, a coat of a Siberian tiger becomes pale so his prey cannot see him as well.
- The cubs of a Siberian tiger do not leave the mothers until they're 3 to 5 years old.
- The average lifetime of a Siberian tiger is 25 years old.
- They are endangered. There are less than 1,000 left.
- Almost all the Siberian tigers live in the south corner of Russia.
